General instructions for Sanskrit and other Indic languages & scripts

Texts in Indic languages should be typeset in Roman characters, using the internationally accepted system of transliteration (see e.g. the *Poona Encyclopaedic Dictionary of Sanskrit on Historical Principles; Poona Comprehensive and Critical Dictionary of the Prakrit Languages*; McGregor's *Oxford Hindi-English Dictionary*, etc.).

Frequently mentioned primary literature should be referred to within the article itself in abbreviated form via common sigla. All sigla and abbreviations should appear at the end of the article in a single alphabetically arranged abbreviations list.
